Quarterly Report : APR - JUNE 2016

During this quarter the children are fully immersed in their preparation for the year end Examinations. So mainly the activities of the Aashram are mainly concentrated on their education and arrangements from the examination point of view.

APRIL 2016:

- (1) Especially this year, the Aashram sent its first batch of SSC students to the Board Examinations. The Examinations were held from March 21st to April 4th 2016 in which all the 12 students that appeared successfully passed with 10 distinctions and 2 first classes. This is a very satisfying and praise-worthy achievement and this certainly augurs well for the future batches as well.
- (2) Ugadi Festival was celebrated in the Aashram with all children dressed in beautiful attires and they were taken to Amaralingeswara Swamy Temple, Amaravathy where they performed Pooja.
- (3) Other students had annual examinations from 14th to 22nd April 2016 and they gave Farewell Party to the SSC Children on 5th April 2016.
- (4) On 27th April 2016, the senior students of SSC appeared for the Polytechnic Entrance Examination.
- (5) The Aashram arranged a Medical Camp on 28th April – 7 doctors, 5 nursing staff and 1 Hospital Administrator conducted the camp and did necessary medical examinations for all the children.
- (6) On 30th April 2016, ten members from Chinmaya Mission, Bombay conducted a Bala Vihar Camp at Chinmaya Vijaya.

May 2016:

- (1) On 1st & 2nd May The Bala Vihar camp was held from 1st to 5th May at Chinmaya Vijaya and this has helped greatly to enrich talents of the children with newer ideas in education and life skills imparted to them.
- (2) Ms Ujwala and Ms Monisha conducted Yoga classes for the children, flower making by Kundans and prepared them for a drama, dance for the Bala Vihar Camp.
- (3) From 3rd to 5th May during the Bala Vihar camp children made Ganesh Pratima, decorated Lord Ganesh, performed the Puja under the guidance of Ms Usha, Srivatsa Chaitanya, and Br. Kushal Chaitanya and prepared and had dance and drama programs in the evening.
- (4) Mementos were given to the camp members and the camp members gave blankets to staff members.
- (5) From 9th to 18th May the children had summer vacations and 21 children went to Pune for a camp from 9th to 30th May. The Pune camp was well organized and it helped the children to know about the culture and development of Chinmaya Organization. They participated very actively in all the activities as evident from the photographs placed below.



- (6) A Craft Teacher was engaged to train the children in making toys and learn craft works like making doormats, rubber bands, covers, baskets, flower vases, paper bags, christmas tree, rabbit etc. The craft teacher taught the children in these activities from 24th May to 11th June in the campus.



JUNE 2016:

- (1) All the 12 students that successfully passed the SSC examination were admitted to Intermediate Course at NRI Junior College, Vijayawada and they started attending classes from 9th June 2016 onwards.
- (2) Out of the 12 students 11 students are continuing intermediate education out of which 9 children opted for BiPC, 2 opted for MPC group. One student was selected for on-the-job training at LVPL Eye Institute, Hyderabad – she is undergoing training with assured job.
- (3) Dr. AppaRao Mukkamala visited the Ashram from 6th to 11th June and motivated the inter students for dedicated performance.
- (4) On 12th Swamiji Anukulananda and Swamy Kushal Ji conducted lot of sports activities for the children at the Ashram.



- (5) Mathaji and Satsang Members from Tenali visited Chinmaya Vijaya. They taught them devotional songs and other mythological stories to the children.

All the children are now busy with their educational activities and as usual the evening tuitions / coaching is regularly done at the Ashram. Dr. AppaRao congratulated all the children for their success in SSC Examinations and also the teachers that guided them so well to achieve distinctions in the first attempt.
